Table Decoration Guidelines

- Table dimensions: 72 inch round; seats max of 8
- Chair dimensions: 36.5" tall, 16.6" deep, 15.5" across
- GP Provides: china, silverware, glassware, and white, pink, or green table cloth
- Electrical outlets are in high demand and are limited. Reserve your table soon to ensure you'll have power!
- Consider the *Girls Place Wish List* when choosing your theme. Please note that table theme and/or décor items do not count towards the \$ugar Mama award, only wish list items.
- You may bring chargers, vases, votives or other contained candles, centerpieces or additional table linens. No lit candles, no open flames, glitter, or confetti.

- Do not adhere anything to walls and floors.
- Please, no political themes or commercial advertising for tables. These tables will not be considered for judging.
- ADA access is available. Please alert Girls Place staff as soon as possible for accommodations.
- Decorating time frame: 2:00 pm 4:00 pm. All tables must be completed by 4:00 p.m. when the ballroom doors close for judging and table setting.
- Each table will have the individual opportunity to be present during judging as directed during the event, but all other participants must leave the ballroom by 4:00 p.m.
- Don't want to decorate? No problem, we will get a beautiful arrangement of flowers for a centerpiece!



Award Criteria

\$ugar Mama (2)

Awarded to the table captains and tables who raise the most for Girls Place beyond the cost of the table. One will be awarded to the table with the largest cash donation and one will be awarded to the table with the largest value of in-kind contributions from the Girls Place Wish List. **All monies and receipts must be turned in to Girls Place by Thursday March 28 and all in-kind products delivered to Girls Place following the event.**

How to Compete for \$ugar Mama!

Enlist the assistance of your guests. Encourage them to go beyond the minimum seat cost.

Seek sponsorship for your table*. Reach out to businesses you know and ask them to become a sponsor of your table. *Purchase of the table, either by individuals or a company, do not count towards the Sugar Mama contest. Only sponsorship dollars and money collected above and beyond the cost of the table will be counted.

Invite your friends who can't attend to contribute to your table. You can send an email, write a letter, or go right out and ask your friends to support Girls Place. You can even direct your friends to our online giving page - **www.girlsplace.net/#donate**. Just be sure they indicate that their gift is to be credited to you!

Hold a bake sale. Nobody can resist homemade treats. Entice even the biggest Scrooge with the smell of brownies, cookies or other baked goods! Or, go healthy and sell apples at your desk!

Encourage your friends to make gifts to Girls Place in lieu of birthday or holiday presents.

Take up a collection at your holiday parties or events.

Hold a Jeans Day at your place of business. Charge your colleagues a few dollars to wear jeans on a Friday. You can even encourage everyone to wear pink for Girls Place that day!

Set a goal and encourage your friends and colleagues to challenge you to do something silly. Challenges could include wearing your pjs to work or kissing a pig! Make it a high goal—you don't want to kiss a pig for nothing!

Collaborate on other fundraising ideas with your guests and friends. Let Girls Place know what you are planning so it can be announced to the public. You'll raise more \$\$ and make a statement about how much helping girls means to you.
